March 15 - Grand Lodge of Texas. P.F & A.M. laid the Cornerstone of Alexander C. Garrett Lodge No. 1216 A.F. & A.M. S. K. Claud L. Austin, Sr., Past M. W. Grand Master, acting as Grand Master. Garrett Commandery furnished uniformed Templar Escort for the Ceremonies.

This was third State competition by Garrett officers -- the first they placed third, the second they placed second, the third they placed First with a Score of 99.1.

August 22 - Charles V. White received the Order of the Temple, the last to be knighted in the Asylum 19212 Greenville Avenue.

Sept. 5 - Last Conclave held in old building where we were privileged to work for four years, two months and 3 days. At this Conclave, the Commandery voted to donate \$500,00 to the A.C.G. Building Fund and \$100.00 on the purchase of a Respirator.

Sept. 27 - Garrett Commandery journeyed to Waxahachie and conferred all the Orders on a class of candidates for that good Commandery.

Oct. 3 - The first Stated Conclave in the new Temple and at the request of Commander Huffhines, Sir Knight Vance K. Miller declared it open as he did at the very first conclave in 1948. Sir Knight Alex D. Fraser was Prelate at this first conclave as he likewise was in 1948.

Sir Knight H. Jack Hefner on behalf of Miss Edith Pavey presented a beautiful lectern with light to the Commandery. This lectern constructed of select birch and finished to match the furnishings of Lodge room.

Nov. 7 - At the request of and on behalf of Sir Knight Vance K. Miller, S. K. Jack Hefner made the presentation of the beautiful oak executive desk with chair and top blotter holder to match. The desk, etc., given to the Commandery by Sir Knight Miller and in turn given by the Commandery to A. C. Garrett Lodge for use of the other bodies. The desk and chair enhanced the beauty of the Asylum and how can we ever adequately express our gratitude to Sir Knight Vance for his kindness and generosity?

Nov. 14 - Sir Knight Vance K. Miller presented to S. K. Cason a sterling silver salver or card tray to use in sending up calling cards or requests to approach the Recorder in his Station at his new desk.

Dec. 14 - Public installation of Sir Knight Harry E. Blanchard as Commander and other Officers. The wives of the officers assisting in the beautiful ceremony. Sir Knight Hefner, installing Commander, S. K. Vance K. Miller, Prelate.

Dec. 25 - First Christmas observance held by Carrett in its own Temple.
